#### **PRELUDE**

## GREETING: (Printed in bulletin.) You are the "Leader."

CALL TO WORSHIP: (Printed in bulletin) *Invite the congregation to stand and join you in reading the call to worship with one of the following:* 

- 1. On this [beautiful\*] day that God has made, let us begin our worship together by reading responsively the Call to Worship. Please stand if you are able. [\*adjective of your choice]
- 2. In gratitude and joy for all of God's blessings, let us worship God using the Call to Worship printed in the bulletin. Please stand if you are able.
- 3. Together let us begin our worship of God by reading responsively the Call to Worship in your bulletin. Please stand if you are able.

#### OPENING HYMN

OPENING PRAYER (Printed in bulletin): Invite the congregation to join you by saying "Let us pray," or by saying: "Please join me in the opening prayer printed in your bulletin. Let us pray..."

### End of Opening Prayer: "Please be seated"

CALL TO CONFESSION (Read one that fits with the Prayer of Confession printed in the bulletin.)

The God revealed to us in the pages of scripture is a welcoming and inclusive God who directs us to love one another. We seek to remove all the barriers that keep us from that love. Let us now confess all that separates us from each other and from God. Let us pray together the Prayer of Confession...

Jesus said, Come to me, all you who labor and are heavy burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me; for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your soul. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.

When we face ourselves and God with the awareness of our need, God gives us grace to grow and courage to continue the journey. Hear the good news: those who are in Christ are a new creation; the old has passed away and behold, the new has come. Thanks be to God!

Friends, God hears our prayers. God loves and values us, forgives what is past, and calls us to new discipleship. Thank be to God!

God's mercy is from everlasting to everlasting. Through Jesus, we are freed to love one another, to forgive one another and to be forgiven. We are given new life. With full and free hearts, let us answer God's gift with our praise, devotion and service.

God knows our soul's longings and with the tenderest love, pours out mercy, compassion and forgiveness on us. Through Christ we are given new and abundant life. Thanks be to God!
